NATIONAL PRIORITIES PARTNERSHIP MEMBER ORGANIZATION SELECTION CRITERIA

Threshold Criterion:

1. Organizational Nomination

The nomination is for an organization, not an individual.

Selection Criteria:

1. Multistakeholder Representation

- ✧ Does the nominee balance the multistakeholder composition of the NPP (e.g., among consumers, purchasers, healthcare providers, healthcare professionals, health plans)?
- ✧ Does the nominee represent a setting in the continuum of care not currently on the NPP but important for setting or achieving national priorities and goals (e.g., ambulatory, rehab, nursing home, home health, hospice)?
- ✧ Does the nominee represent a professional group not currently on the NPP but important for setting or achieving national priorities and goals (e.g., hospitalists, case managers, allied health professionals)?

2. Capacity to Support Implementation of NPP Priorities & Goals

- ✧ Is the nominee a critical stakeholder not currently represented on the NPP that could make important contributions to the implementation of the priorities and goals (e.g., states responsible for implementing federal legislation)?
- ✧ Is the nominee a Federal partner that will be responsible for implementing programs that directly impact the priorities and goals?

3. Diversity

- ✧ Does the nominee represent diverse or underserved populations not currently represented by the NPP (e.g., race, ethnicity, gender, lifestage)?
- ✧ Does the nominee increase the geographic diversity of the NPP?
