Background

- American Taxpayer Relief Act (2012) authorized Commission on Long-Term Care: Report to Congress*
 - ▣ *Findings*
 - » \$130 billion/year for long-term services and supports (LTSS)
 - » Expect dramatic LTSS growth in next 20 years
 - ▣ *Recommendations*
 - » Improved focus on quality in LTSS
 - » Particular attention to home and community-based services (HCBS)

2014 NQF HCBS Report

- HHS awarded a Task Order to NQF to convene a multistakeholder Committee
 - ▣ *Identify HCBS measurement gaps*
 - ▣ *Prioritize measurement opportunities*
- The 2014 Committee identified 11 domains for measure development, including person-centered planning and practice (PCPP).

Current PCPP Landscape

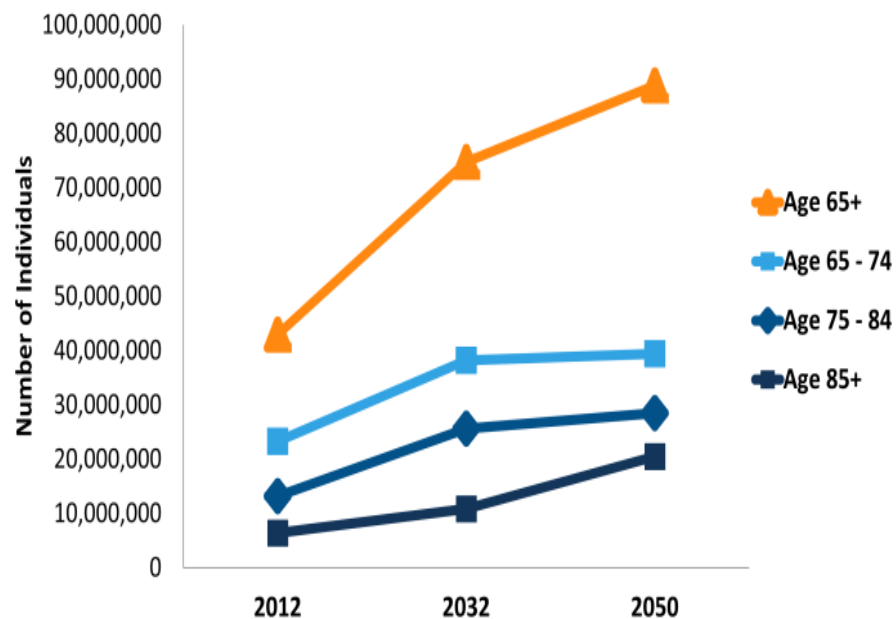
- States struggle to implement PCPP
- States have requested federal assistance in PCPP:
 - *Operational definitions*
 - *How to reconfigure systems to support PCPP*
 - *How to structure payment for PCPP*
 - *How to select and implement quality measures to effectively evaluate the impact of PCP*

Future Need

- 21 million Americans expected to require LTSS and PCPP
- In 2012, KFF estimated that:
 - ▣ *Of Americans 65+, 70% will use LTSS*
 - ▣ *Americans who are 85+ are 4x as likely to need LTSS than those ages 65-84*

Project Goals

Definition(s) for PCP

Develop set of core competencies for performing PCP facilitation

Provide recommendations to HHS on system characteristics which support PCP thinking, planning, and practice

Develop conceptual framework for PCP measurement

Conduct environmental scan including the historical development of PCP in LTSS systems to include a research agenda for future PCP research

- Project staff has completed ACL PCP training
- Drafting definition(s) for PCP
 - ▣ *Expand PCP definition developed by the NQF HCBS Quality Committee*
 - ▣ *Address competencies and practice standards to tackle variations at the practice level*
 - ▣ *NQF will conduct a peer-reviewed literature search (including relevant NQF reports)*
