What is NQF's role in the ICD-10 transition?

- Ensure all NQF-endorsed measures have a set of ICD-10 CM/PCS codes on October 1, 2014
 - Via annual updates and 3-year maintenance reviews
- Provide measure developers with recommendations and best practices for transitioning quality measures to ICD-10 CM/PCS
 - 2009 Expert Panel and report
- Connect developers to transition resources as needed
 - AHIMA/other developers

ICD-10 CM/PCS Transition: Challenges and Implications for quality measurement

- Lack of testing databases with dual coded data
 Inability to test ICD-10 coded measures
- Anticipated interruptions in trending of measure results
- Measure intent for some measures may change based on increased specificity of ICD-10 codes
- Multiple tools available for transition
- Developer funding to complete coding transition for NQF-endorsed measures

Recommended Coding Conversion Best Practices

Convene Clinical and Coding Experts

The team should be used to identify specific areas where questions of clinical comparability exist, evaluate consistency of clinical concepts, and ensure appropriate conversion.

Determine Intent

The most ideal way to convert code sets for quality measures would be to examine the original intent of the measure and select codes directly from the target code set to define the concepts rather than relying on mapping alone.

Use Appropriate Conversion Tool

- Assess for Material Change
 - For existing measures undergoing coding updates and maintenance, the extent to which the population identified with the new code set overlaps with that identified in the old code set should be assessed, if possible.

Recommended Coding Conversion Best Practices (cont.)

Solicit Stakeholder Comments

Conversion to new code sets requires involvement of many stakeholders; measure developers should solicit comments from a wide audience for additions and deletions, and with specific attention to new codes.

Version the Updated Measure

 Different versions of measures may be used longitudinally for various purposes but may not be exactly comparable.

Required Documentation







Take advantage of the more specific code set

The intent of the measure has changed.

2. Code Tables: New Measure or Measures Undergoing Maintenance

NQF Measure Submission Form, Version 6.0, Specifications tab

2a1.30. Data Dictionary or Code Table (Please provide a web page URL or attachment if exceeds 2 pages. NQF strongly prefers URLs. Attach documents only if they are not available on a web page and keep attached file to 5 MB or less.)



3. Process: New Measures or Measures Undergoing Maintenance

Enter process of determining ICD-10 codes into the Validity section, data field 2b2.2. Analytic Method

If ICD-10 testing data is available, enter that into the Validity section, data field 2b2.3. Testing Results

If necessary, add attachments at bottom of Scientific Acceptability tab, data field 2.1. Supplemental Testing Methodology Information

3. Process: Annual Update

- Document the process of determining the ICD-10 codes (Word or PDF), including:
 - Names and credentials of experts
 - Summary of stakeholder comments
 - Results of any testing
- Send attachments to <u>measuremaintenance@qualityforum.org</u> when submitting Annual Update
 - Cannot add attachments to Annual Updates online at this time, so NQF staff will do it behind the scenes

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Endorsement Maintenance Updates
