## **Expedited Review Process**

The NQF Consensus Development Process (CDP v1.8, adopted May 2007) includes an option for an expedited consideration. In order to meet emerging national needs, the Board of Directors approved a series of changes to the expedited consensus development process. The approved modifications should allow for accelerated endorsement for projects with associated time-sensitive legislative or regulatory requirements. Final changes from the prior expedited process are noted below in bold:

**Expedited Consideration**. In recognition that some measures are very wellestablished, widely used, or urgently needed to meet a national need, application of the CDP may proceed via an expedited process. CSAC approval of expedited consideration should be obtained prior to commencing such a review. For expedited reviews, the nominating process for SC members shall be no less than 10 business days (instead of 30 calendar days); the call for measures shall be no less than 10 business days (instead of 30 calendar days); the review and comment period for draft documents shall be no less than 10 business days (instead of 30 calendar days); and the voting period shall be no less than 10 business days (instead of 30 calendar days).

<u>All</u> of the following criteria should be met prior to consideration by the CSAC for an expedited review:

- 1. the extent to which the measures under consideration have been sufficiently tested\* and/or in widespread use
- 2. whether the scope of the project/measure set is relatively narrow
- 3. time-sensitive legislative/regulatory mandate for measures

\*EHR-based measures will require only semantic testing using EHR test beds
