Updated measure submission form versions were published for use in the fall 2022 cycle:

Changes to the measure submission forms include:

- New question for eQMs in the Measure Specifications section: “Attach the simulated testing attachment”.
 - Question Sp.11 in the quality measure form
 - Question Sp.12 in the cost and resource use measure form
 - Question Sp.11 in the composite measure form
- New yes/no question for all measures in the Measure Specifications section: “Is this measure adjusted for socioeconomic status (SES)”?
 - Question Sp.20 in the quality measure form
 - Question Sp.37 in the cost and resource use measure form
 - Question Sp.20 in the composite measure form
- Clarifying language and examples were added to the following questions regarding sampling methodology in the Measure Specifications section:
 - Question Sp.27 in the quality measure form
 - Question Sp.27 in the composite measure form
- Instructions on how to distinguish between previous submission information and new submission information was edited to comply with section 508 requirements:
 - Current submission:**

- Question 2b.21 was previously available only for risk adjusted or stratified measures. All measures including those which do not fit cleanly into risk adjustment or stratification categories now have a field to explain why there is no detailed risk model included.
- New question for eQMs in the Previous Submission Information section: “If this eQm has a registry version, provide the NQF# of the previously submitted measure”.
