

Action Registry

An online space for organizations to share their health and healthcare improvement activities and results

There is intense national focus on improving health and healthcare. Many organizations across the country have taken up the charge, looking for new ways to meet their goals, new partners to work with, and a forum where ideas can be exchanged in real-time. Those on the frontlines of change have expressed a need for more information-sharing and collaboration space, so they can accelerate their improvement initiatives. In response, the National Quality Forum has created the **Action Registry**—an online forum that fosters sharing and networking among partners involved in improving health and healthcare.

The Action Registry is an *online space for organizations to share their improvement activities—or “actions”—and make connections with each other.* It can be found at <http://www.qualityforum.org/action-registry>



The Action Registry offers the opportunity for its users to share activities or initiatives they are undertaking, along with their results, so that others might learn from these experiences. When an organization shares their experience, they help others identify tactics that have proven successful elsewhere, avoid pitfalls, and offer concrete solutions to overcome barriers.

To add your organization's actions to the registry, click on the "Add an action" option on the left side of the page. From there, you will be prompted to fill out a form describing your action, goals, partners, results, and any barriers you encountered along the way. The Action Registry also allows you to attach files and hyperlinks, which is helpful for sharing fact sheets, white papers, or websites.


