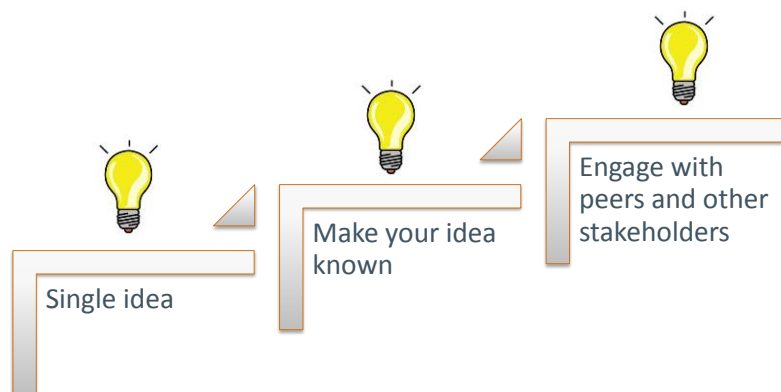

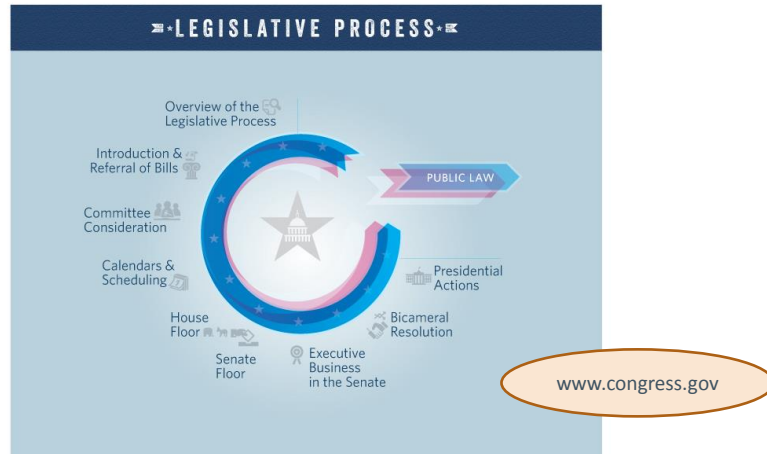

**Legislation may be introduced in either chamber except for tax law, which must originate in the House **Most major legislation goes to conference committee; When one chamber passes legislation originating in the other without making changes, bill goes directly to President*

How is Federal Policy (Legislation) Created? (cont.)

General route for a bill to becoming law:

1. Bill is introduced (dropped in the hopper)
2. Referred to Committee
3. Voted out of Committee
4. Voted on the Floor
5. Sent to other chamber to go through the process
6. Sent to the President and signed into law
