- One comment received from one NQF member
- One member expressed nonsupport for both measures evaluated during the spring 2019 cycle.

3495 Hospital Wide 30-Day, All-Cause, Unplanned Readmission (HWR) Rate for the Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) Eligible Clinicians and Eligible Clinician Groups

- One comment raised concerns about the CDP and potential reliability and validity issues.
- Action: The Committee should review the comment and the developer's response. The Committee should then discuss and formalize their response.
 - The Committee has the option to let its recommendation to endorse measure 3495 stand, or the Committee may reconsider and vote again on whether the measure should be recommended for endorsement.
