2	Patient(s) with atrial fibrillation and evidence of problematic atrial fibrillation control that had cardiology consultation in last 12 reported months - This measure identifies patients with two or more recent atrial fibrillation ER encounters or hospitalizations or a cardioversion encounter for atrial fibrillation that had cardiology consultation within the last 12 reported months. 3	Patient(s) treated with an antibiotic for acute sinusitis that received a first line antibiotic - This measure identifies patients with acute sinusitis treated with an antibiotic who received a first line antibiotic.	Ingenix
4	Patient(s) with an emergency medicine visit for non-traumatic chest pain that had an ECG - This measure identifies patients with an emergency medicine visit for non-traumatic chest pain that had an ECG done as part of their evaluation.	Ingenix
5	Patient(s) with an emergency medicine visit for syncope that had an ECG - This measure identifies patients with an emergency medicine visit for syncope that had an ECG done as part of their evaluation.	Ingenix
6	Patient(s) 2 years of age and older with acute otitis externa who were NOT prescribed systemic antimicrobial therapy - This measure identifies patients 2 years of age and older with acute otitis externa who were or were not prescribed systemic antimicrobial therapy.	Ingenix
7	Adult(s) with community-acquired bacterial pneumonia that had a CXR - This measure identifies patients with community-acquired bacterial pneumonia treated as outpatients that had a CXR.	Ingenix
8	Patient(s) with inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) complications that had gastroenterology consultation in last 3 reported months - This measure identifies IBD patients with two or more recent IBD ER encounters or a hospitalization for IBD that had gastroenterology consultation within the last 24 reported months. 9	Patient(s) with frequent ER encounters or frequent acute medication use that had an office visit in last 6 reported months - This measure identifies patients with frequent migraine ER encounters or frequent migraine abortive medication use that had an office visit within the last 6 reported months. 11	Patient(s) with an asthma related hospitalization or ER encounter in last 3 reported months or frequently using short-acting beta2-agonist inhalers that had an office visit in last 3 reported months - This measure identifies patients with a recent asthma ER encounter, asthma hospitalization, or frequent short-acting beta2-agonist inhalers that had an office visit within the last 3 reported months.
