Project Scope

- 44 measures will be reviewed in the project over two phases
 - The measures address the following topic areas:

Phase 1:

- Hematology
- >Melanoma
- Prostate cancer
- Palliative care for cancer patients at the end of life
- Medical and radiation oncology
- Lung cancer
- Phase 2:
 - Colorectal cancer
 - Breast cancer

Comments

- Phase 1:
 - There were 109 comments received on the phase 1 draft report from 14 member organizations.

Comment themes:

- The comments overall were largely supportive of the Steering Committee recommendations for endorsement.
- Concern regarding the clarity and burden of measures 0383 and 0384 (Oncology Pain measures)
- Request for reconsideration of measure 0562: Overutilization of Imaging Studies in Melanoma
- Concern regarding the understandability and usability of the Palliative Measures (0210-0216)
- Request for reconsideration of measure 0212: Proportion with more than one hospitalization in the last 30 days of life

Impact of Comments

Measures 0383 and 0384

- Recommendations for elimination of patients with mild pain from the denominator in future updates of the measures.
- Reconsideration of measure 0562
 - Reversal of initial recommendation that the measure not be endorsed.
- Palliative measures (0210-0216)
 - Reaffirmation of the intent of the measures, which is to demonstrate variation in practice, not set a threshold for the interventions to never occur.
- Reconsideration of measure 0212
 - Reaffirmation of the Steering Committee's recommendation that the measure not be endorsed.
