0097: Medication Reconciliation	National Committee for Quality Assurance	Percentage of patients aged 65 years and older discharged from any inpatient facility (e.g. hospital, skilled nursing facility, or rehabilitation facility) and seen within 60 days following discharge in the office by the physician providing on-going care who had a reconciliation of the discharge medications with the current medication list in the medical record documented.
0171: Acute care hospitalization (risk-adjusted)	Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services	Percentage of patients who had to be admitted to the hospital
0173: Emergent care (risk adjusted)	Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services	Percentage of patients who had to use a hospital emergency department
0228: 3-Item Care Transition Measure (CTM-3)	University of Colorado Health Sciences Center	Uni-dimensional self-reported survey that measure the quality of preparation for care transitions.
0326: Advance Care Plan	National Committee for Quality Assurance	Percentage of patients aged 65 years and older who have an advance care plan or surrogate decision maker documented in the medical record or documentation in the medical record that an advance care plan was discussed but the patient did not wish or was not able to name a surrogate decision maker or provide an advance care plan
0494: Medical Home System Survey	National Committee for Quality Assurance	Percentage of practices functioning as a patient-centered medical home by providing ongoing, coordinated patient care. Meeting Medical Home System Survey standards demonstrates that practices have physician-led teams that provide patients with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Improved access and communication</li> <li>b. Care management using evidence-based guidelines</li> <li>c. Patient tracking and registry functions</li> <li>d. Support for patient self-management</li> <li>e. Test and referral tracking</li> <li>f. Practice performance and improvement functions</li> </ul>
0511: Correlation With Existing Imaging Studies for All Patients Undergoing Bone Scintigraphy	American Medical Association - Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement	Percentage of final reports for all patients, regardless of age, undergoing bone scintigraphy that include physician documentation of correlation with existing relevant imaging studies (eg, x-ray, MRI, CT) that were performed
0520: Drug Education on All Medications Provided to Patient/Caregiver During Episode	Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services	Percent of patients or caregivers who were instructed during their episode of home health care on how to monitor the effectiveness of drug therapy, how to recognize potential adverse effects, and how and when to report problems
0526: Timely	Centers for	Percent of patients with timely start or resumption of home

0553: Care for Older Adults – Medication Review (COA)	National Committee for Quality Assurance	Percentage of adults 65 years and older who had a medication review
0554: Medication Reconciliation Post-Discharge (MRP)	National Committee for Quality Assurance	Percentage of discharges from January 1 to December 1 of the measurement year for patients 65 years of age and older for whom medications were reconciled on or within 30 days of discharge.
0645: Biopsy Follow-up	American Academy of Dermatology	Percentage of patients who are undergoing a biopsy whose biopsy results have been reviewed by the biopsying physician and communicated to the primary care physician and the patient.
0646: Reconciled Medication List Received by Discharged Patients (Inpatient Discharges to Home/Self Care or Any Other Site of Care)	American Medical Association - Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement	Percentage of patients, regardless of age, discharged from an inpatient facility to home or any other site of care, or their caregiver(s), who received a reconciled medication list at the time of discharge including, at a minimum, medications in the specified categories
0647: Transition Record with Specified Elements Received by Discharged Patients (Inpatient Discharges to Home/Self Care or Any Other Site of Care) (Inpatient Discharges to Home/Self Care or Any Other Site of Care)	American Medical Association - Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement	Percentage of patients, regardless of age, discharged from an inpatient facility to home or any other site of care, or their caregiver(s), who received a transition record (and with whom a review of all included information was documented) at the time of discharge including, at a minimum, all of the specified elements.
0648: Timely Transmission of Transition Record (Inpatient Discharges to Home/Self Care or Any Other Site of Care)	American Medical Association - Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement	Percentage of patients, regardless of age, discharged from an inpatient facility to home or any other site of care for whom a transition record was transmitted to the facility or primary physician or other health care professional designated for follow-up care within 24 hours of discharge

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0649: Transition Record with Specified Elements Received by Discharged Patients (Emergency Department Discharges to Ambulatory Care [Home/Self Care])	American Medical Association - Physician Consortium for Performance Improvement	Percentage of patients, regardless of age, discharged from an emergency department (ED) to ambulatory care or home health care, or their caregiver(s), who received a transition record at the time of ED discharge including, at a minimum, all of the specified elements
