Fall 2018 Cycle Measure Review

One New Measure Evaluated

- 3474 Hospital-level, risk-standardized payment associated with a 90-day episode of care for elective primary total hip and/or total knee arthroplasty (THA/TKA)
 - Committee recommended for endorsement
 - No public comments
- CSAC Decision

Spring 2019 Measure Evaluation Process

Cost and Efficiency: Spring 2019 Cycle

- 8 measures submitted by CMS/Acumen
- 3 will be reviewed by the Standing Committee this cycle
 - **3509** Routine Cataract Removal with Intraocular Lens (IOL) Implantation
 - **3510** Screening/Surveillance Colonoscopy
 - **3512** Knee Arthroplasty
- 5 to be reviewed in future submission cycle (did not pass Scientific Methods Panel)
 - **3508** Elective Outpatient Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI)
 - **3511** Revascularization for Lower Extremity Chronic Critical Limb Ischemia
 - **3513** Simple Pneumonia with Hospitalization
 - **3514** Intracranial Hemorrhage or Cerebral Infarction
 - **3515** ST-Elevation Myocardial Infarction (STEMI) with Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI)

Measure Evaluation Inputs to the Standing Committee





NQF Scientific Methods Panel Review

The Panel consists of individuals with statistical expertise

- Established to help ensure consistent evaluation of the scientific acceptability of complex measures
- Evaluate reliability and validity
- Measures that did not pass because of issues related to reliability testing
- Did not achieve consensus among SMP group on empirical validity testing

Technical Expert Panel Review

7 TEPs

- Cardiovascular
- Ophthalmology
- Vascular Surgery
- Orthopedic Surgery
- Gastroenterology
- Internal/Family Medicine
- Neurology
- Charged with review and providing feedback on clinical logic, episode trigger and end definitions, clinical exclusions, clinical risk factors for risk adjustment
- Qualitative feedback only
- Feedback on measures that did not pass the SMP will be summarized and provided to the developer

Standing Committee Review

- Review will occur over 2 webinars on June 27th in lieu of in-person meeting
- Standing Committee members will have 3 weeks to review 3 measures
 - *Review materials:*
 - » Measure worksheet
 - Measure Information Form (MIF) specifications
 - Summaries of NQF SMP preliminary analyses
 - Summaries of NQF clinical TEP preliminary analyses,
 - NQF staff preliminary analysis
 - Testing attachment
 - » Supplemental specification and testing documents
 - Complete the preliminary analysis survey (survey monkey)
- Lead discussant selections will be distributed prior to the meeting

Cost and Resource Use Measure Evaluation Criteria Updates

Importance

Evaluation of disparities now handled under Validity (2b4, 2c)

- Focuses on:
 - » Demonstration of measure focus that is high impact, AND
 - Demonstration of cost problem, considerable variation across providers (opportunity for improvement)

Scientific Acceptability

- No significant changes
- Feasibility
 - No changes
- Usability and Use
 - No changes
- Updated criteria document with general guidance
