Revised Framework for Measurement of Diagnostic Quality & Safety

Structure

- People
- Workflow & Tasks
- Technology & Tools
- Organizational Features/Characteristics
 - Includes culture, leadership, physical environment & organizational QI efforts
- External Environment

Process

Patient Engagement

- Includes access to care, participation in the diagnosis, and communication about the diagnosis between provider and patient
- The Diagnostic Process
 - Includes evaluation, clinical reasoning steps, diagnostic testing, consultation with specialists, care coordination, and patient follow-up

Outcome

- Intermediate/Diagnostic Outcomes (e.g., accuracy, timeliness, errors)
- Patient Clinical Outcomes (e.g., psychological, physical, financial impacts of diagnosis)
- Patient Experience (*e.g., satisfaction*)
- System Outcomes (e.g., costs, efficiency, public confidence)
