Overview and Expectations for Webinar

Document Structure and Thought Process

- Subdomains and measure concepts should result in the desired outcome through measurement
 - Any subdomain/measure concept that could not be achieved from measurement was removed
- Subdomains and measure concepts should be clear and distinct
 - Subdomains and measure concepts that were not unique or unclear were reworded or merged
- A measure concept should be a full description of the measure, including planned target and population.
 - Any measure concepts that were not fully developed were classified as an "Idea" or updated to meet the requirement of a measure concept

Guiding Principles

- Interoperability is more than EHR to EHR
- There are various stakeholders from different settings involved- each group should be clearly defined
- "Electronically exchanged data" should be used instead of "outside" data
- There are factors affecting Interoperability that are important but outside of the scope of measurement

- Consensus on Measure Concepts and Existing Measures
 - Still able to update as we move forward but at least comfortable with the measures for the purposes of developing the framework

Major Changes

Exchange of Electronic Health Information

- Updated definition of "Exchange" domain to better include concept of availability
- Merged data flow into method of exchange
- Added clarity to subdomain of "data content and quality"

Usability of Exchanged Electronic Health Information

Merged timeliness, accessibility and completeness into relevance

Impact of Interoperability

Added clarity to subdomain of "quality"

Measure Concepts/Measures
