

# Review Progress on Environmental Scan of Measures

#### Identifying and Tagging Measures

- Scan and tagging conducted for 2015 Rural Health Project
  - Included NQF portfolio and other publicly available measure sets
  - Tagged CMS program measures
  - Tagged rural-relevant measures for small hospitals, CAHs, and rural health clinics
  - Tagged for topic/conditions
- Updating the Scan
  - NQF endorsement work since 2015
  - Relevant NQF measurement framework projects
    - » Home and Community-Based Services
    - » Telehealth
    - » Roadmap for Promoting Health Equity and Eliminating Disparities
    - » Medicaid Innovation Accelerator
    - » Emergency department transitions of care
    - » Diagnostic quality and safety
  - Refresh tagging (e.g., federal programs PCMH program, etc.)

#### Scan Summary To-Date

- >1200 measures identified for 2015 rural health project
  - Includes duplicate measures and measures for other levels of analysis/care settings
- Other NQF scans of measures
  - Tagging information (e.g., telehealth, access, etc.)
  - Includes measure concepts

- Not worthwhile to merge data from scans
  - Instead, we will pull in information as needed to inform work
  - May need WG input to identify other measures/sources

### Workgroup Feedback To-Date

#### Summary from Nov 29 Webinar

- NQF-proposed criteria
  - NQF-endorsed
  - Address low case-volume
  - Cross-cutting measures
- Workgroup feedback
  - Supported starting with NQF endorsed measures
    - » May need to look elsewhere for specific topic areas
  - Must address low case-volume
  - Measures that assess care transitions must be included

#### Summary from Nov 29 Webinar

- Additional Workgroup feedback
  - Keen interest in measures of access to care
  - Open to consideration of cost measures
  - Coordination of care is key rural issue (transitions; collaboration between providers)
  - Feasibility is important, but some high-value measures might be included, even if less feasible
  - Some disease-specific measures might be reasonable to include in a core set



### Post-Webinar Survey Results: Measure Selection Criteria

- Cross-cutting measures are necessary
  - BUT disease-specific/chronic condition measures also relevant
- Should be relevant to unique rural health care delivery challenges (e.g., travel distance)
- Would like to include patient outcomes
- Don't lose sight of the principles of actionable/suitable for internal QI

#### Other Proposed Topics

- Geriatric or other areas related to elder care
- Outcome measures
- Care coordination across multiple providers
- Preventive actions (e.g., immunizations, health improvement/maintenance around common problems of population)
  - Prevention of obesity/diabetes
- Provider competence, credentials
- Trauma and emergency services
- Cancer care (post-diagnosis)
- Swing bed quality

# Apply Preliminary Selection Criteria and Discuss Results

### Measures After Applying Preliminary Selection Criteria

- 608 NQF-endorsed measures
- Of these, 543 potentially relevant to hospital or ambulatory settings (e.g., excludes nursing home/inpatient rehab/home health/inpatient psychiatric facilities/hospice)
- Of these, 140 are cross cutting; of these:
  - 2 deal with transitions
  - 4 deal with care coordination
  - 4 deal with emergency services
  - 11 deal with patient/family experience with care
  - 11 deal with immunization
  - 2 deal with medication reconciliation

## Measures After Applying Preliminary Selection Criteria (continued)

- 140 are cross cutting; of these:
  - 8 are other instrument-based outcome measures (e.g., communication climate, patient activation)
  - 6 deal with readmissions
  - 18 deal with safety/complications (e.g., falls, pressure ulcers)
  - 16 deal with screening
  - 2 are structural (skill mix, nursing hours)
  - 2 deal with substance abuse
  - 16 deal with perinatal or maternal issues
  - 4 deal with pediatrics
  - 6 deal with healthcare acquired conditions

### Measures After Applying Preliminary Selection Criteria

- Of these, 140 are cross cutting; of these:
  - 8 are other instrument-based outcome measures (e.g., communication climate, patient activation)
  - 6 deal with readmissions
  - 16 deal with safety/complications (e.g., falls, pressure ulcers)
  - 16 deal with screening
  - 2 are structural (skill mix, nursing hours)
  - 2 deal with substance abuse

### Measures After Applying Preliminary Selection Criteria

- 30 diabetes-related measures
- 1 hypertension measure
- 3 cost measures
- Access measures: TBD
- → Can find NQF-endorsed measures for almost all desired issues/topics (most are cross-cutting)

#### **Questions to Consider**

- Any other specific conditions of interest?
- Any specific procedures of interest? (e.g., surgery)
- What about measures for dialysis facilities?
  - Initially, have assumed out-of-scope
- Are you still interested in "access" measures?
  - If so, how do you want to define?

### Rural-Relevant Measurement Topic

#### **Proposed Measurement Topics**

- Measuring access to care
- Leveraging public and private resources for quality improvement efforts
- Appropriate comparison groups
- Post-acute care in rural areas
- Telehealth?
- Advance care planning?
- Swing beds?

- 32 measures submitted
  - 22 for clinician programs (MIPS and/or MSSP)
  - 9 for hospital programs (HIQR, HOQR, ASCQR, PCHQR, ESRD QIP)
  - 1 for post-acute/LTC programs (SNF QRP)

## 2017 Measures Under Consideration: Discussion Questions

- Staff identified the following measures as rural relevant (i.e., particularly relevant to and appropriate for rural providers)
  - MUC17-195: Hospital-Wide All-Cause Risk Standardized Mortality
  - MUC17-196: Hybrid Hospital-Wide All-Cause Risk Standardized Mortality
  - MUC17-258: CoreQ: Short Stay Discharge Measure
  - MUC17-178: 30-Day Unplanned Readmissions for Cancer Patients
  - MUC17-181: Optimal Diabetes Care
  - MUC17-194: Optimal Vascular Care
  - MUC17-310: Zoster (Shingles) Vaccination
