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
Playbook Over the past year, NQP has worked to bring together over 40 public- and private-sector leaders and subject matter experts to develop a common agenda and identify and implement strategies to improve antibiotic practices among providers, healthcare organizations, and local communities. The Playbook makes recommendations for organizations including hospitals, accreditation bodies, and patient and consumer groups to enhance their stewardship activities to prepare for these changes. The *Playbook* attempts to lay out the implementation examples as a broad range of what is possible and achievable while recognizing that what will be effective depends heavily on local circumstances. While measures related to AS are improving, success depends on local execution taking into account local culture and the need for behavior change The Action team has provided guidance to influence provider practices and drive change more quickly in a way that is meaningful and sustainable NATIONAL QUALITY FORUM

- Based on these Core Elements, this Playbook provides concrete strategies and suggestions for organizations committed to implementing successful ASPs in acute care hospitals. This Playbook has incorporated examples of successful implementation, more specifics concerning the core elements, barriers and solutions for implementation, potential measurement approaches, and future directions. In each section hyperlinks to resources are provided to support local efforts
- The document is **not** a list of "must do's" to be completed. Instead, the *Playbook* attempts to lay out a variety of options from which to choose depending on local context, resources, and needs. We hope this document will enable success at the local level


- Impressive list of national experts with diverse healthcare backgrounds and leading organizations will help us to gain internal and external support
