6	Undetermined	Percent of Residents Who Exhibit More Signs and Symptoms of Being Depressed or Anxious (Chronic Care)
7	Undetermined	Percent of Low-Risk Residents Who Lose Control of Their Bowels or Bladder (Chronic Care)
