



Project Objectives

- NQF has convened a panel of experts that will
 - review opioid-related quality measures and concepts
 - » Peer-reviewed and grey literature
 - » Existing measure sets
 - » State-based laws
 - » Key stakeholders
 - develop a set measurement priorities moving forward
 - » For federal programs
 - » At large



Committee Composition

 Pain or substance use disorders treatment experience/expertise

AND

- Specific knowledge in one or more of the following
 - Medicare/Medicaid/private payer
 - Rural health
 - Primary care (internal medicine, pediatrics, OB/GYN)
 - Specialty care (emergency, surgery)
 - Pharmaceutical services or drug development
 - Measure development
