


Figure 1. PRO-PM Roadmap: Each column contains one stage, and the bidirectional arrows indicate that tasks can move freely and be iterated across stages.



Today's Focus: Priority Findings from Klls

- Recommendations from five or more interviewees:
 - Strengthen the overall structure of the Roadmap
 - Provide improved guidance on digital measurement
 - Discuss issues related to burden and workflow that are unique to PRO-PMs
 - Explain tradeoffs in data collection strategies for a PRO-PM



Discussion: Updates to Existing Tasks

- The KIIs identified 13 improvement opportunities within the existing Roadmap tasks

Discussion: Acknowledge Issues Related to Burden and Workflow

- Stage 2 Recommendation: The Roadmap should acknowledge and offer solutions that address both clinician and patient burden related to data collection
- Stage 3 Recommendation: Add guidance to the Roadmap to help measure developers overcome challenges related to identifying and securing test sites for PRO-PMs
