Background

This report reflects the review of measures in the Patient Experience and Function project. The National Quality Forum's (NQF) portfolio of measures for Patient Experience and Function includes measures of functional status, communication, shared decision making, care coordination, patient experience, and long-term services and supports.

The 23-person Patient Experience and Function Standing Committee reviewed four measures. Four were recommended for endorsement; no measures were not recommended for endorsement; and the Committee reached consensus for all of the measures.
