Re: Patient Safety, Spring 2020 Cycle: CDP Report

Background

This report reflects the review of measures in the Patient Safety project. Measures in the Patient Safety portfolio target various patient safety events and practices across healthcare settings. In this review cycle, measures span several types of healthcare settings and are connected to important areas in patient safety, including medication reconciliation, hyperglycemia, bladder catheterization, and urinary tract infections.

The 23-person Patient Safety Standing Committee reviewed two maintenance measures. Both measures were recommended for endorsement.

Recommended Measures:

- **NQF 2723** Wrong-Patient Retract-and-Reorder (Wrong Patient-RAR) Measure (New York-Presbyterian Hospital)
- NQF 3558 Initial Opioid Prescribing for Long Duration (IOP-LD) (Pharmacy Quality Alliance)
