

Patient Safety Standing Committee: In-Person Meeting Summary June 17-18, 2015

The Patient Safety Standing Committee met in-person on June 17-18, 2015, at the NQF offices in Washington, D.C. to evaluate 23 measures and conduct an ad hoc review of 3 measures. Additionally, they provided feedback and guidance on the role of the standing committee in overseeing the NQF Patient Safety portfolio of measures.
