Patient Safety – Complications: Project Overview

Goal: To identify, evaluate, and endorse performance measures that specifically address patient safety measures with a focus on high-volume complications for accountability and quality improvement purposes

Phasing

- Phase 1 (began in May 2011)
 - Medication safety, VTE, surgery, and care management
- Phase 2 (began in April 2012)
 - Falls, pressure ulcers and healthcare-associated infections
 - 14 measures recommended
 - 12 maintenance measures; 2 new measures
- Same Committee for both phases
