- Re: Perinatal and Women's Health Spring 2021 Technical Report

Background

This report reflects the review of measures in the Perinatal and Women's Health project. The National Quality Forum's (NQF) portfolio of measures for Perinatal and Women's Health includes measures for reproductive health, women's health, pregnancy/labor and delivery, high-risk pregnancy, newborns, and postpartum patients. The 25-person Perinatal and Women's Health Standing Committee reviewed four maintenance measures. All four measures were recommended for continued endorsement.

Recommended Measures:

- #0033 Chlamydia Screening in Women (National Committee for Quality Assurance)
- #2902 Contraceptive Care Postpartum (U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office of Population Affairs [HHS OPA]/Far Harbor)
- #2903 Contraceptive Care Most & Moderately Effective Methods (HHS OPA/Far Harbor)
- #2904 Contraceptive Care Access to LARC (HHS OPA/Far Harbor)

The Standing Committee requests comments on all measures, but specifically for the measure where consensus was not reached.
