Review and Discuss Public Comments



3543 Patient-Centered Contraceptive Counseling (PCCC) measure

■ Measure Steward: University of California, San Francisco

Brief Description of Measure:

■ The PCCC is a four-item patient-reported outcome performance measure (PRO-PM) designed to assess the patient-centeredness of contraceptive counseling at the individual clinician/provider and facility levels of analysis.

Summary of Comments Received: [21 comments; 17 in support]

- No measure for inquiring about a patient's history of family planning, or respect for pregnancy intendedness
- No inclusion of information on a situation where a patient would like to become pregnant
- Survey Point 4 language implies the provider has all knowledge and expertise needed for the patient to make the 'best' decision
- Limited description of the diversity within study samples
- Submission is not explicit about the inclusion of marginalized communities in the development of this measure
