Re: Prevention and Population Health Spring 2020 Report

Background

This report reflects the review of measures in the Prevention and Population Health project. Measures included in this portfolio assess the promotion of healthy behaviors, community-level indicators of health, oral health, and primary prevention strategies.

The 25-person Prevention and Population Health Standing Committee reviewed two measures. One was recommended for endorsement and one measure did not pass validity – a "must-pass" criterion.

NQF 0032 Cervical Cancer Screening (National Committee for Quality Assurance)

Measure Not Recommended:

 NQF 0509 Diagnostic Imaging: Reminder System for Screening Mammograms (American College of Radiology)
