Transition of the Quality Data Model (QDM): Project Overview

 - HHS contracting with MITRE Corporation for QDM Maintenance.

Harmonization efforts with HL7 standards

- HL7 is currently in the process of aligning standards related to Health Quality, which includes the following:
 - Harmonizing information models
 - » QDM and other HL7 specifications
 - Harmonizing expression logic
 - » QDM and other HL7 specifications
 - Harmonizing common metadata
- Goals
 - Produce a more *complete* QDM specification
 - » Clean definitions and other ambiguities
 - » Use this new QDM to HL7 harmonization activities

MITRE: Next Generation QDM

- Objective
 - Improve the quality and reduce the cost and time to develop eCQMs while moving to the Next Generation QDM
- Assuming responsibility of QDM in January 2014
- Working collaboratively with eCQM and CDS community
 - Resource Center, Work Groups, Committees, etc.
- Developing "QDM2"
 - Syntax, grammar, expression logic, operators, functions
 - Harmonized model of QDM with Clinical Decision Support
- QDM periodic assessment and continuous improvement through user feedback, metrics and performance indicators
