During the Option Period, the Technical Guidance underwent a series of modifications across several key areas:

- Added specificity to the evidence standard for risk factor inclusion in the conceptual model (pg. 21);
- Added specificity and guidance with respect to "locus of control" and "meaningfully influence" (pg. 24);
- Added guidance for determining bias of a factor that is not accessible in a data source of sufficient quality (pg. 31);
- Increased attention to health equity throughout the guidance and noting the role of risk adjustment within efforts to improve health equity (pg. 3, 17, 41, 45);
- Added specificity to the guidance sections of calibration and stratification, including minimum variable sets for each (pg. 37 & 40);
- Changes to the minimum standards to reflect the above-listed guidance modifications (pg. 18);
- Update to the NQF Policy section (pg. 44);
- Updated the Executive Summary and Conclusion (pgs. 3 & 46); and
- Added Stakeholder Feedback as Appendix F (pg. 97).



NQF Public and Member Comment Approach

- NQF updated the Technical Guidance following a series of focus groups and web meetings with the TEP and Federal Liaisons.
- NQF posted the Technical Guidance for public comment from August 31, 2022 to September 21, 2022.
- NQF also sent out several external announcements about the public comment period across its network, including those who have signed up for project alerts. NQF's additional outreach included:
 - MIDS C3 forum listserv
 - Measures Management System newsletter
 - Focus Group Participants
 - Measure and Instrument Development and Support C3 Forum



Key Themes from Public Comments

- NQF received nine comments from four organizations:
 - Acumen, LLC.
 - America's Health Insurance Plans (AHIP)
 - Kidney Care Partners
 - Yale University School of Medicine
- Also received comments from two TEP members
- Key themes identified:
 - Provide clarity
 - Requirements for Consensus Development Process (CDP)
 - Stratification guidance
 - Burden to developers
 - Stakeholders
