Synthesized Trauma Domains

Table 1. Synthesized Domains and Example Subdomains

Domain	Subdomain
Access to trauma services	 Capacity of services Availability of services Timeliness of services
Trauma health outcomes	 Acute care Post-acute care Longitudinal care Population, person, caregiver
Cost of trauma care	 Patient cost System level cost Population level cost
Prevention of trauma	*Outside of scope of this project. Serves as a placeholder for future projects.
Equity of trauma care	* Independent domain or included as a component of the above domains.

Access to Trauma Services

- Dominant theme in all breakout groups
- Example subdomains include:
 - Capacity of Services
 - Availability of Services
 - Timeliness of Services

Trauma Health Outcomes

- Domain is consistent with current quality metrics and associated with continuum of care
- Example subdomains include:
 - Acute care
 - Post-acute care
 - Longitudinal Care
 - Population

Cost of Trauma Care

- Domain allows a connection between health outcome and cost to determine value of care delivered
- Example subdomains include cost at:
 - Patient level
 - System level
 - Population level

Prevention

- Important to include but outside the scope of this project
- Project begins with point of injury

Equity

- Committee support for equity in the framework
- Social Risk Adjustment and Stratification represented in other domains
- Should equity be represented as a stand-alone domain?

- 1. Do you agree with the general direction of the above domains? What else should be added? What should be removed?
- 2. For the purposes of this measurement framework, is it ok to state that trauma begins at the point of injury (while acknowledging the importance of prevention)?
- 3. Should there be a standalone "Equity" domain or should it be seen as a pervasive theme amongst the other domains? If it is a standalone domain, what are some example subdomains, measures, or measure concepts that would belong in that domain?
