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#### **MAP Background and Strategy**

Session led by Mark McClellan, Clinician Workgroup Chair, and Tom Valuck, Senior Vice-President, Strategic Partnerships, NQF.

- Dr. McClellan welcomed the workgroup and reviewed the meeting objectives.
- Dr. Valuck reviewed MAP's statutory authority, structure, and recently-released three year <u>Strategic Plan</u> (2012-2015). He emphasized the importance of feedback loops that are built into MAP's structure and work.

# **MAP Pre-Rulemaking Approach**

Session led by Aisha Pittman, Senior Program Director, Strategic Partnerships, NQF.

- Ms. Pittman reviewed the four-step pre-rulemaking approach for 2013:
  - Building on MAP's prior recommendations,
  - Evaluating each finalized program measure set using MAP's Measure Selection Criteria,
  - Evaluating measures under consideration for what they would add to the program measure sets, and
  - o Identifying and prioritizing gaps for programs and settings.
- Ms. Pittman also explained new aspects of pre-rulemaking this year, such as the role that MAP's families of measures and core measure sets will play, as well as more specific rationale regarding MAP's decisions on each measure.

#### **Evaluating Program Measure Sets**

Session led by Aisha Pittman. Additional presentations by Mitra Ghazinour, Project Manager, Strategic Partnerships, NQF; Kathryn Streeter, Project Manager, Performances Measures, NQF; and Amaru. Sanchez, Project Analyst, Strategic Partnerships, NQF.

- Aisha Pittman and additional NQF program staff provided an overview of the five federal programs that the Clinician Workgroup will likely review during the 2013 pre-rulemaking process.
- NQF staff reviewed information that will be made available to the workgroup members prior the inperson meetings to assist them in their evaluations, such as program summary sheets and any relevant information regarding HHS' uptake of MAP's 2012 recommendations.

## **Evaluating Measures Under Consideration**

Session led by Allen Leavens, Senior Director, Strategic Partnerships, NQF.

- Dr. Leavens provided information about this year's process for evaluating the measures under consideration.
- He reviewed the sample discussion guides that will be used, and also explained how information about performance and measure use will be incorporated into materials to inform MAP discussion.

 A commenter asked how cost measures will be handled. Ms. Pittman discussed that due to the limited availability of NQF-endorsed cost and resource use measures, the Clinician Workgroup's input will likely focus on measures needed to adequately address cost within clinician programs.
