eMeasure Learning Collaborative Evaluation and Feedback

- Response Rate :
 - Attended in-person: 24
 - Attended via Web: 6
 - Total completed evaluations: 27
 - Total respondents: 31
- Satisfaction of 'Opening Session' speakers
 - Kate Goodrich, MD - 83.8% were 'very satisfied' or 'satisfied' (26 respondents)
 - Farzad Mostashari, MD – 90.4% were 'very satisfied' or 'satisfied' (28 respondents)

eMeasure Learning Collaborative Evaluation and Feedback (cont'd)

■ Evaluation Elements

- The breakout session achieved its stated objective – 82.8% ‘strongly agree’ or ‘agree’ (24 respondents)
- The closing session report outs were effective – 70.0% ‘strongly agree’ or ‘agree’ (21 respondents)
- The eMeasure Learning Collaborating meeting was effective in identifying:
 - » Best practices – 74.0% ‘strongly agree’ or ‘agree’ (20 respondents)
 - » Gaps - 88.8% ‘strongly agree’ or ‘agree’ (24 respondents)
 - » Recommendations – 77.7% ‘strongly agree’ or ‘agree’ (21 respondents)
