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Transition to ICD-10

10/1/2011

- NQF now requires ICD-9 and ICD-10 for all measures

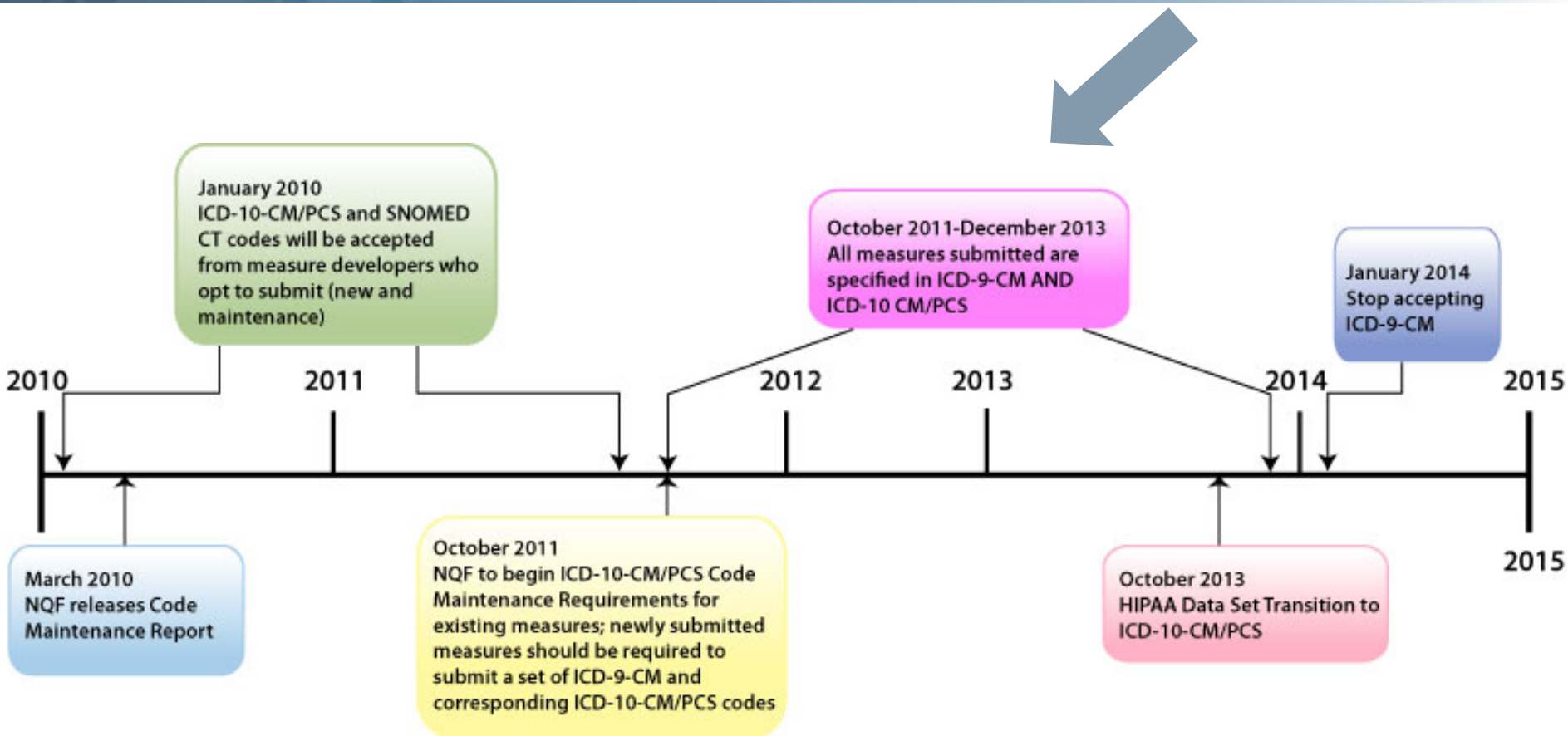
10/1/2013

- ICD-10 required for HIPAA transactions

1/1/2014

- No longer accept ICD-9 for NQF measures

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3. Process: Annual Update

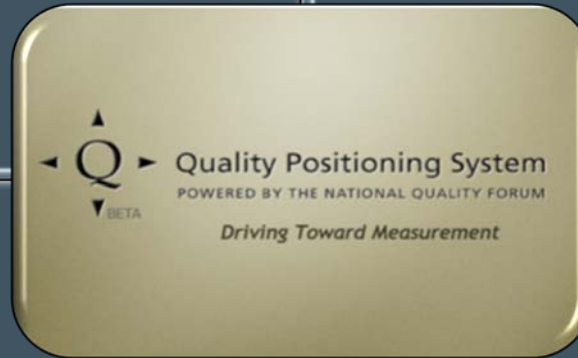



NQF: Time-Limited Test Data Submission

Measure Title : Validated family-centered survey questionnaire for parents' and patients' experiences during inpatient pediatric hospital stay

Measure Number : 0725

2a1.1. Numerator Statement *(Brief, narrative description of the measure focus or what is being measured about the target population, e.g., cases from the target population with the target process, condition, event, or outcome)*

The 62-item survey evaluates parents' experiences during inpatient pediatric hospital stay.

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2a1.2. Numerator Time Window *(The time period in which the target process, condition, event or outcome is eligible for inclusion)*

Surveys received from parents of pediatric inpatients that were received within 6 week after sending the survey out to the parents that were randomly selected from all parents with children who had inpatient stays during a certain time period prior to sending the survey out, e.g., the prior month.

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2a1.3. Numerator Details *(All information required to identify and calculate the cases from the target population with the target process, condition, event, or outcome such as definitions, codes with descriptors, and/or specific data collection items/responses)*

The dimensions that are included are overall impressions, interactions with nurses, interactions with doctors, the admission and discharge process, home care preparation, medications, pain management, parent involvement, hospital environment, support staff and food. Demographic questions are included at the

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2a1.4. Denominator Statement *(Brief, narrative description of the target population being measured)*

Randomly sampled parents or caregivers, 18 years or older, of children who had an inpatient stay of at least one night at the hospital and responded to the survey.

Submitting Standards

NQF endorses performance measures and practices as voluntary consensus standards. Interested stewards and/or developers of measures or practices may submit their standards for consideration by NQF.

Online Measure Submission

To submit a measure, a steward must complete and electronically submit the online measure submission form for each measure they wish to submit to NQF for consideration.

NQF is now using an online *Measure Submission Form, Version 5.0*. The new online submission form includes a variety of new features and allows the user to:

- Gain secure access to the submission form from any location with an internet connection;
- Save a draft version of the form and return to complete it at his or her convenience; and
- Print a hard copy of the submission form for reference.

Measure Evaluation

If time-limited endorsement:

- Update should be included with time-limited review

Annual Update Process

Notice provided at start of quarter

Updates due at end of quarter

One reminder sent if not received

NQF review completed within 45 days of end of quarter

Next Steps:

- Updated to NQF Web site (if no material changes made)
- Ad hoc review (if material changes made)

2012 Review of Time-Limited Endorsements

Testing results due 12 months after endorsed

Include Annual Update documentation

Referred to CSAC for decision

- Remove time-limitation
- Remove endorsement

If due for Endorsement Maintenance

- TLE will be done then
